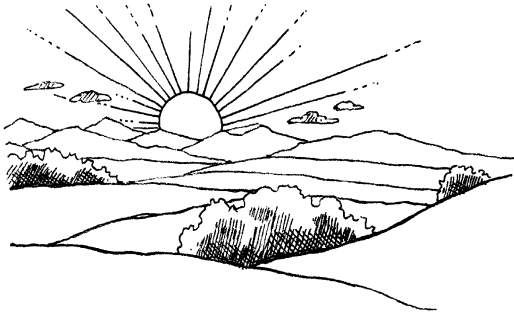


The Second Sunday of Ordinary Time January 17, 2010

Yes, it's that time of year again. It's time to start planning for our annual Ash Wednesday Fish Fry on February 17, following 5:30 pm Mass.

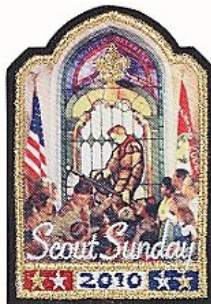
