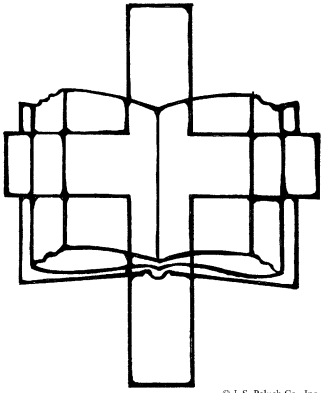

A Married Couples Retreat

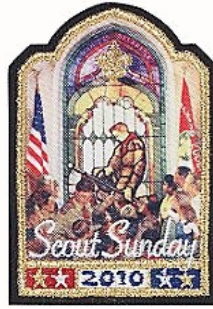


**“VALENTINE’S MARRIED COUPLES
