ARE YOU AN ALTAR SERVER? WOULD YOU LIKE TO BE ONE? READ ON!

Since it's summer and theoretically you are free in the daytime, I thought I would try something a little different for altar servers' training.

Here it is: I will be available right after the 9 AM Mass or Communion Service on the next three Tuesdays (July 13, 20 and 27) to teach you or to refresh what you already know of what to do during Mass. On July 27 there will be Mass, so you would have a great opportunity to practice serving during the Liturgy.

Whether there is Mass or a Communion Service, we would meet immediately after that (about 9:30) in the church, to learn for the first time or to review what altar servers should know. If you have a *Manual for Altar Servers*, bring it and a pencil with you to these meetings.

If you are a new server (or if you have a friend who would like to be a server), you should definitely plan to come.

If you have been serving for a long time, you should definitely plan to come to renew and refocus yourself and to help the new servers.

But please **DO** let me know whether or not you can make it to one or all of the dates listed above (agoroch@stjchurch.org or 455-2249). And also please **DO** talk to your friends who might also like to be altar servers. Invite them to come along. – Maybe you could even carpool!
