Franciscan Worker News

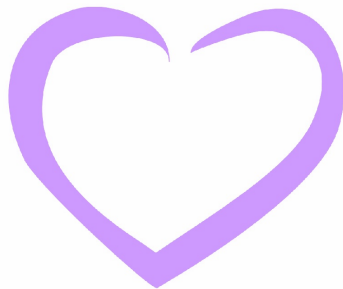
