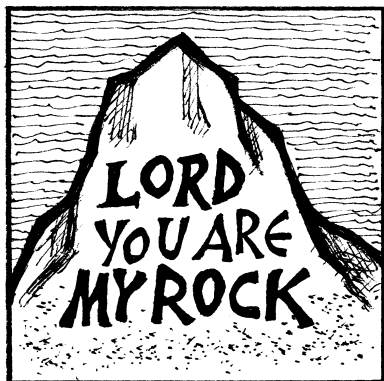


The Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time June 1, 2008

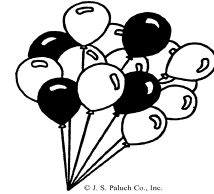

Cursillo Gatherings for all Cursillistas and those interested in Cursillo

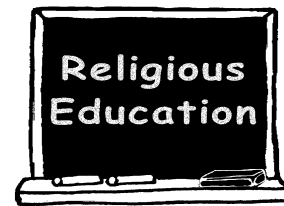
