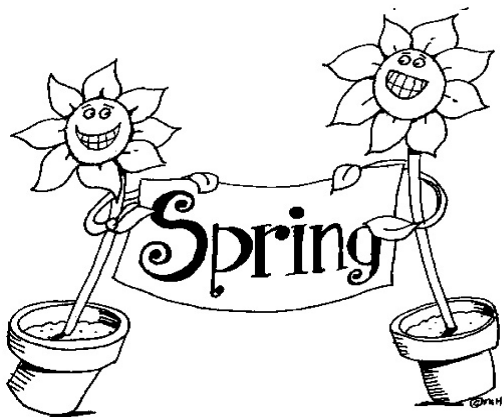
THANK YOU!
