ST. JOSEPH'S PODCAST

Father Jim's most recent homilies, vintage homilies, reflections given at special events, all these are at your fingertips...

We've been Podcasting for about three years now. We've gone from computers to faster mobile devices, smartphones, netbooks, tablets, and who knows what else. One thing remains constant: Father Jim's homilies are available to you whenever you want them!

There are a couple of ways to get the Podcasts of the weekly Mass readings and Father Jim's homilies, retreats, and other special things like Father Jim's

40th Anniversary Mass and the Good Friday Stations of the Cross. Here's the easy way, this requires iTunes on either a computer or a handheld/mobile device, like an iPhone or an iPad:

- Go into iTunes and get into the iTunes Store.
- In the Search box type Spreckels.
- There you'll find St Joseph's Podcasts.
- You can load individual episodes and subscribe.

Another easy way, also requires iTunes (the download is free). just go to the Parish Website at www.stjchurch.org then go to Bulletins, and then to 'Get Podcast'.

Here's another way, a little harder, but it works almost everywhere: type this into a browser window:
