St. Joseph's parish is looking for an office assistant to fill in for Astrid while she is on maternity leave.

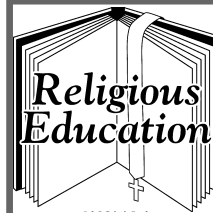
