

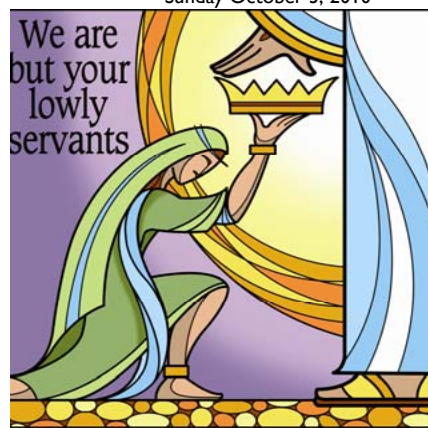

Also thank you to the businesses and individuals who donated items and gift certificates to the silent auction.

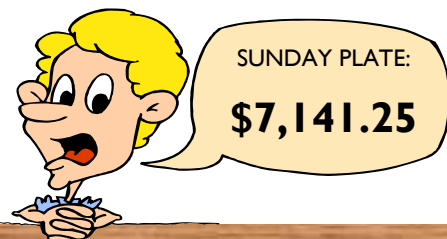
Hope to see you all again in Spreckels Park next year!
