### Sacred Heart School News Victoria Torcolini, Principal

" . . . This year, we were forced to dramatically increase tuition from \$3,700.00 to approximately \$4,800.00, after several years of operating at a stiff deficit. We hated to do this, but it was either raise tuition or shut down.

"For years SHS has been educating the children of all the parishes up and down the Route 101 corridor from King City to Prunedale/Castroville. Sacred Heart Church has always given the school a substantial amount of financial assistance. Now we are also asking for help from the other parishes. . ."
